Construction

The larger 439 offers even more choices and customization options while maintaining the excellence, quality and safety features the Island Packet Brand is famous for. We are committed to building YOUR boat to meet YOUR cruising and sailing needs. She features 2 staterooms with en suite heads and stall showers. The master stateroom has an island berth with customizable storage and/or seating options on the port side.

There is also a large aft walk-in area that can serve as a 3rd stateroom, a workshop/storage area or even an extended galley pantry. The port side salon can also be configured to your needs. A few examples include: two captain chairs, full settee, navigation station and/or additional storage. You can choose the Solent or Cutter rig design, hard and soft good colors/textures and interior wood materials. So get creative and the Island Packet Design Team will work with you to build YOUR Island Packet.

- One-piece integral hull and keel of 100% hand laminated high modulus knitted fiberglass infused with a proprietary pressure-fed application system. Light ivory gelcoat with urethane painted boot stripe.
- Fully encapsulated lead ballast forms double bottom over length of keel. No keel bolts to maintain, loosen or leak.
- Skeg hung, protected rudder
- Coosa Composite in lieu of marine plywood
- Molded structural interior grid unit bonded with hull and interior bulkhead system to form unified structure.
- Tri-axial woven roving fiberglass cloth
- High-quality, vinyl ester resins
- Chainplates, made of 316L annealed stainless, interlocked and bonded directly with hull structure for secure “belt-and-suspenders” installation.

Large drop-leaf table folds against the bulkhead for an open salon with dedicated wine and glass storage cabinet behind.
- Portside standard is two captain's chairs with a folding table in between. There are many different custom options available to suit your needs such as full settee, navigation station, and/or additional storage units.
- Aft stateroom to port with pillow top, tall coil, 7 1/2" innerspring queen-sized mattress, privacy door to salon and ensuite head with stall shower. Cedar-lined hanging locker with automatic light when opened.
- On the starboard side, aft of the galley is a third cabin that can be finished as a third berth sleeping area, a walk-in workshop/storage area or a pantry/storage extended pantry.
- Large galley featuring a deluxe three-burner Force 10® LPG stove (with oven and broiler, stainless steel sealed burner top, guard rail with harness hooks, lift-off cover, storage under), Vitrofrigo refrigerator/freezer (drawer units), dish rack and utensil drawers, under counter storage for dry goods, seamless Corian or under-mount SS galley sink with a Corian sink filler insert (stows in cabinet), trash bin under sink, microwave, solid acrylic countertops with integral fiddles, molded slip-resistant sole.
- Forward owner's stateroom with offset island berth, pillow top, tall coil, 7 1/2" innerspring queen-sized mattress with storage underneath, settee, privacy door to salon and ensuite head with stall shower. His and hers cedar-lined hanging lockers with automatic light when door is opened.
- Head compartments with separate stall, stand up showers w/ sitting bench and bi-fold doors as well as solid acrylic counters with integral fiddles and vanity cabinet storage with large mirror above the sink. They also feature electric flush heads w/ tank monitor, molded slip-resistant soles and choice of a vessel or under mount sink.
- SeaGull® IV water filter for freshwater (cold) at dedicated faucet at galley sink.
- Numerous SS opening ports with safety glass and screens throughout; numerous overhead hatches with retractable screens/shades.
- Premium Sapele hardwoods, veneers and coordinated surfaces for bulkheads, cabinetry, and trim. Louvered raised panel cabin doors; louvered locker doors, extensive radius corner detailing, cedar-lined lockers and drawers.
- Furniture quality satin gloss varnish applied to all interior wood surfaces in a multi-coat process.
- Hinged solid Sapele companionway ladder with slip-resistant treads, easy engine access with pneumatic pistons for raising and holding up.
- Sapele grate at the base of companionway lifts to reveal removable dust pan, bilge access.
- Overhead salon handrails and numerous bulkhead mounted SS handrails throughout for safety and security.
- Storage rack for companionway boards

A 3-bladed fixed prop (feathering prop optional), Yanmar® fuel filter with water separator mounted for easy access. Jacketed fuel lines with swedged and threaded fittings, intake strainer.
- Yanmar® C Engine Panel with temperature and oil pressure gauges.
- Engine access from hinged front stairs and rear panels, hinged side opening doors. Pre-plumbed for electric oil change system.
- Extensive sound-control with premium lead-lined insulation, gasketed access doors and panels.
- Five (4) house Lifeline 31 XT AGM batteries, 125 ah each
- One (1) dedicated start battery, Lifeline 27 AGM, 100ah
- Inverter 5000 peak/100 amp charger
- 30 amp AC dockside power system with ELCI ground fault inlet protection breaker and one (1) 50-foot shore power cord. Numerous outlets, GFCI protected.
- Engine instrument panel with tachometer, hour meter and engine monitoring system.

- Pressure water system with hot and cold service to galley, head and cockpit shower. UL® listed eleven (11) gallon water heater with engine heat exchanger, insulated hot water hoses throughout. Dedicated head, sink/shower drain sump with strainer.
- LPG system with 10-pound aluminum tank in self-draining storage compartment with gasketed, lockable lid, remote solenoid, dual safety shutoffs and gauge; room for extra tank.
- Fuel, water and holding tanks below cabin sole maximize storage and stability and minimize trim changes with varying tank fluid levels.
- Fuel tank (160 gallons) constructed of welded, baffled heavy gauge marine-grade aluminum (5052-H32) with shut off valve, s/s deck fill, tank mounted mechanical gauge. Pre-plumbed with second pickup/return for addition of generator and/or heater system.
- ThermoCure™ freshwater tank (260 gallons) constructed of infusion molded fiberglass using FDA approved vinyl ester resins, baffles, s/s deck fill, electronic remote tank level gauge.
- Infusion molded fiberglass holding tank (55 gallons) with baffles, s/s deck pump-out fitting, electronic remote tank level gauge.
- Heavy-duty electric bilge pump with auto control and premium electronic pump switch. BilgeAlert® high water bilge alarm with remote alarm panel at helm.
- UL listed bronze, thru-bolted, flanged seacocks on all thru-hulls below the waterline; ball valves on thru-hulls in boot stripe.
- Masthead anchor light, foredeck/steaming light on the mast, nav lights, all LED.
- Pre-wired for anchor windlass installation, bow thruster cables, fan and speaker wires throughout interior, VHF cable in mast and from mast step to nav area; messengers pre-run for pulling additional wire.
